



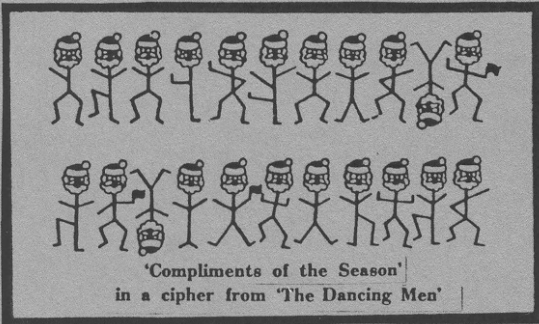
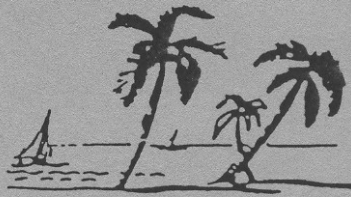

MORSTAN MUSHROOMS

Dr. Watson's bride often prepared mushrooms in this tasty manner, as an accompaniment to a roast of beef or lamb.

| 1/3 c. chopped onions | 1 1/2 c. bread cubes |
| 2 T. chopped green pepper | 1/4 t. salt |
| 1/4 c. butter | 1/4 t. thyme |
| 3 eggs, beaten | 1 1/4 c. milk |
| Two 4 oz. cans sliced mushrooms, incl. liquid | |
| Dash of pepper | |

Sauté onions & pepper in butter until tender. Combine with remaining ingredients, and pour into buttered baking dish. Bake in 350° oven for 50 - 60 minutes. Serves 6.
