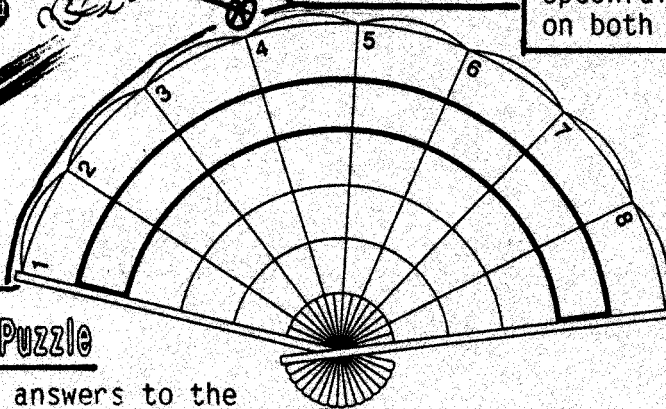

'FLODDIES'

(As accompaniment to a roast of beef or lamb, this tasty potato dish adds a gourmet touch to any meal. Mrs. Hudson often served it to Mr. Holmes.)

- 1 large potato, peeled & grated
- 1 tablespoon grated cheese
- 1 egg, beaten
- Dry mustard, salt, pepper, chopped parsley, dried herbs, etc. to taste
- Oil or fat for shallow frying

Mix together the potato, cheese & egg, then add enough flour to make a pancake mixture. Add whatever seasoning you desire. Fry spoonfuls of the mixture until golden brown on both sides. Drain & serve hot. Serves 2.
