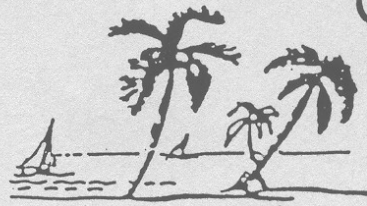

From Mrs. Hudson's Kitchen

CULLEN SKINK



(Mrs. Hudson often served this delicious Scottish smoked haddock soup. It has a wonderful golden color and a marvelous smoky flavor. "Skink" is a Gaelic word meaning essence.)

- 1½ lbs. smoked haddock fillets
- 2 c. milk
- 1 medium-sized onion, finely chopped
- 3½ c. water
- 1 c. diced raw potato
- 1 oz. butter
- 1 c. heavy cream
- Salt
- Freshly ground black pepper
- ½ c. chopped parsley

Put the smoked haddock in a large, shallow pan with the milk, onion & water. Bring slowly to a boil & remove from the heat. Lift the fish out of the pan, skin and bone it, and flake it into small pieces, then set aside. Place the skin and bones in a saucepan with the cooking liquid & the onion. Add the potato, and simmer for 1 hour.

Strain the stock through a sieve and return it to the saucepan. Heat thoroughly and add the fish, butter and cream. Season to taste with salt & pepper, then sprinkle the parsley over the top just before serving. Serves 6.
