Holmes: "Yes, Watson, and I understand that it's a novel of great depth."

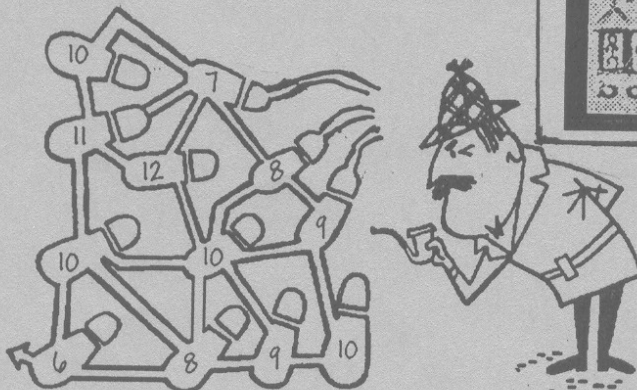
Holmes: "I say, Watson, did you see this? The Yard has arrested a dishonest dressmaker."

APPLE NUT CRUNCH

(Mrs. Hudson's caveat:

"Enjoy this succulent after-dinner sweet, but don't use the apples from Appledore Towers.)

|--------------|-----------------------------|
| 1 egg | 1 tsp. baking powder |
| 3/4 c. sugar | 1/8 tsp. cinnamon |
| 1/3 c. flour | Dash nutmeg |
| | 1/2 c. chopped peeled apple |
| | 1/2 c. chopped walnuts |
| | 1 tsp. vanilla extract |

Beat egg in bowl. Combine sugar, flour, baking powder, cinnamon & nutmeg; add to egg and beat until smooth. Fold in apple, nuts and vanilla. Spoon into greased 8" square baking pan. Bake at 350° for 25-30 minutes. Cool. Serve with a dollop of vanilla ice cream. **Makes 9 servings.**

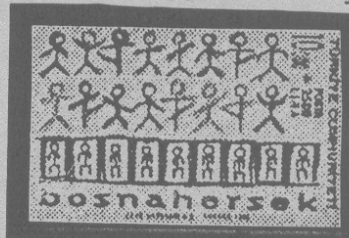


Philatelic Philandering
